Application Guideline (For international students)

<u>Niigata University Summer Program 2022</u> Niigata University Online Pre-Study Abroad Program: Learn Japanese culture and society through language learning and discussion with Japanese students

♦Aim

Niigata University (NU) will offer the Summer Program 2022. The program is designed for students from our partner universities who will learn remotely from their home country with NU students. It provides students with opportunities to study not only Japanese language and culture but also develop their capabilities to study in Japan, and contribute to the globalizing world in different social settings in the future. The program offers two separate courses for the first four days, each designed for international students and NU students. On the final day of the program, all students participate in discussion together so that they can interact with each other through collaborative online international learning (COIL).

<u>Program for International Students:</u>

Four days: From Monday, August 22 to Thursday, August 25

This course aims at providing international students who wish to study in Japan in the future with preliminary understanding regarding Japanese contemporary affairs through intensive Japanese reading.

• <u>Program for NU's students</u>

Four days: From Monday, August 22 to Thursday, August 25

This course aims at providing NU students who wish to study abroad in the future with broader knowledge about contemporary Japanese affairs so that they will be able to explain various topics regarding Japan in English.

• Program for collaborative online international learning

One day: Friday, August 26

On the final day of the program, NU students make presentations about contemporary Japanese affairs in English, and international students make questions about the presentations. After that, all students have a discussion together and exchange their views and opinions on the topics regarding Japanese contemporary affairs.

♦Eligibility

An applicant must meet all of the following requirements.

- (1) The applicant is enrolled as a degree-seeking student during the period of the program in a university with which Niigata University has concluded a student exchange agreement.
- (2) The applicant has basic (minimum JLPT-N4) or intermediate (minimum JLPT-N3) level of Japanese language proficiency.
- (3) The applicant has sufficient English language proficiency.
- (4) The applicant is expected to attend all the scheduled classes to complete the program successfully.

♦Method

The entire program will be conducted online via Zoom. Students are required to have laptops/PCs, (build-in) cameras, and microphones.

♦Schedule

Japan Standard Time (JST) is used in the following schedule. The schedule is tentative, and we will inform you of the fixed one at a later date.

♦ Student Status at Niigata University

♦Credit and Evaluation

Students will be evaluated according to their performance, including participation and discussion. Two credits and the certificate will be given by NU after the successful completion of the program.
