

Online Summer Course in Shizuoka University in 2022

1 Purpose

Participants communicate with diverse students from various countries including Shizuoka University(SU) in Japanese language. The main activity is to discuss “Intercultural Society”, one of the goal of SDGs being particularly tackled in Shizuoka Prefecture, in relation to race, languages, education, gender equality, welfare, poverty and labor through Problem Based Learning. They think collaboratively about problem-solving that they can do, and then they will be able to see themselves and the world from a different perspective when they return to their own societies after this course. In addition, the participants enjoy Japanese culture and a discussion on, for example, “life of our University” “working style in Japan” etc. with SU students.
