

Application procedures for the exchange program at Kasetsart University in fall 2024

Dear Partner,

Greetings from Faculty of Economics, Kasetsart University, Thailand.

I was informed by my colleague at the Kasetsart University International College (KUIC) that you are looking for a class schedule at the Faculty of Economics for this fall semester 2024 (August to December). Please see the information below.

Application process

1. Please note that the 1st semester period at KU is from **5 August to 16 December 2024**. The full academic schedule is not yet published. Please refer to the table of academic schedules below instead.
2. Your students are encouraged to arrive here prior to the orientation day for international students on **2 August 2024**.
3. After the nomination, your students can start the online application for an exchange program with KU. Please visit this [website](#) for the link to online application form as well as the required application documents.
4. Once your students submit the applications, Ms. Annika, the admission staff from KU International Affairs Division (IAD) will soon proceed with their application to the selected faculty. If you have any questions related to application status or admission process, please direct it to her at iad@ku.th
5. The nominated students are required to choose only one program as their official host program under one faculty for semester exchange at KU. As Wageningen has an existing university-level agreement with KU, your students can choose any programs offered by our university in the online application. In case they choose to enroll in the Faculty of Economics, please feel free to put me as their coordinator.
6. After they are accepted to the selected programs, Ms. Annika will send them the Letter of Acceptance individually. Please ensure that they apply for the non-immigrant Education visa to Thailand.

Enrollment requirements

- Students are required to mainly register in the courses offered by their host program. Please choose carefully.
- In the case of cross-faculty/program registration, students are allowed to choose 1 or 2 courses from other remaining programs within the host faculty or outside of the host faculty.
- The non-degree exchange students are exempt from prerequisites, but be mindful and be sure they have an adequate foundation before attempting to enroll in advanced classes.
- Maximum course load at KU is 7 courses per semester; minimum is 3 courses.

Earned credits at KU

- Students will normally earn 3 KU credits (equal to 6 ECTS) from most of our offered courses.
- Class Hours per Class per Semester: 15 weeks of classes x 1 class hour (50-60 min) x 3 credits = 45 Class Hours
- 3 credits-course means that they will need to study 3 class hours per week.

Study programs at Faculty of Economics

I am providing you the offered programs under my faculty in case it might be of interest to your students below.

1. EEBA (Bachelor of Arts in Entrepreneurial Economics)

This is a hybrid between Economics and Business Administration focusing on entrepreneurial studies. The study field includes logistics, tourism and hospitality, finance, and food and agri-business enterprises.

2. BEcon (Bachelor of Economics)

BEcon is a mainstream economics program focusing on development and planning, business economics, international economics, monetary economics and finance. If the students are more familiar with mathematics, statistics and econometrics and also have studied Microeconomics and Macroeconomics for at least 2 years, they may try choosing this program as the host.

- The course syllabi on the provided link are from the previous academic year or older for your students to have a look of the course outlines as it is likely similar year to year. The course schedule (day and time) is not up to date.
- The new class timetables of the EEBA program for the 1st semester in August will be updated and sent to exchange students around 1 month prior to the first day of semester (probably in July 2024).
- Students may take a look from the old class timetables and course syllabi to select the appropriate courses for their study plans.
