#### I. University Activities under the UC Program

Participation to UC activities

### 36<sup>th</sup> Executive Board Meeting at NTU

The authorized representatives of Kasetsart University, namely Asst. Prof. Dr. Naroon Waramit, Dean, School of Integrated Science, and Asst. Prof. Dr. Jitsopin Meerakate, Assistant to the President participated in the 36<sup>th</sup> UC Executive Board Meeting at National Taiwan University, Taipei, Taiwan during 30-31 October 2023.

#### 9<sup>th</sup>Graduate Forum at UGM

Two presenters from Kasetsart University attended the 9<sup>th</sup> UC Graduate Forum with the theme "Sustaining Our Future: Circular Economy in Animal Production, Agriculture, and Forestry" at UGM, Yogyakarta, Indonesia, on 17-18 July 2024.

Mr. Thanawat Nithiwutratthasakul, MS student in Sustainable Land Use and Natural Resourse Management, presented his study on the *Effect of Variety and Harvest date on Chemical Composition and Paper Physical Property of Napier Grass*, under the Innovation and Practices in Circular Economy session.

- Updates on the status of approval/implementation of the ERASMUS+ funded MS
   FSCC project

- 1) The MS FSCC Program (Master Degree in Food Security and Climate Change) is currently under the Kasetsart University International College (KUIC). The academic committee of the college has been working on developing the courses under the program.
- Updates on the activities and deliverables conducted/developed/attended for the ERASMUS+ funded PMC FSCC project
  - 1) The PMC FSCC project officially started on 1 December 2023. However, the implementation of the project began early January 2024. As the PMC FSCC Project Lead, Kasetsart University began launching the project by holding the Project Kick-off Meeting between 31 January and 1 February 2024 at Kasetsart University, Bangkok. The main objective of the Kick-off Meeting was to communicate important details of the project to the entire team to ensure that all partners understand the expectations, deliverables, milestones and their deadlines. In addition, the budgetary issues and financial management were discussed at the Kick-off Meeting. At the meeting, resource speakers from different sectors, including academia, government, industry, and non-governmental organizations were given the opportunities to discuss the need for the offering of postgraduate micro-credentials in food security and climate change. Examples of the resource speakers included representatives from Thailand Department of Climate Change and Environment, Thailand Office of Agricultural Economics, the Regional Community Forestry Training Center for Asia and the Pacific (RECOFTC), the Wyss Academy for Nature, Sweden-funded EXPLORE project, USDA Thailand Regional Agriculture Innovation Network (RAIN) and Winrock International. The Kick-off Meeting also featured presentations on existing micro-credentials offered by project member universities and plans of activities committed by each Work Package. On the second day of the Meeting, the three committees were created the Steering Committee, the Conflict Resolution Committee, and the Quality Assurance Committee.

The Steering Committee is chaired by Dr. Buncha Chinnasri (Project Coordinator, KU, Thailand). The members include Dr. Maria Cristeta Cauresma (SEAMEO SEARCA, Philippines), Dr. Hatma Suryatmojo (UGM, Indonesia), Prof. Dr. Zalilah Mohd Shariff (UPM, Malaysia), Dr. Hendrix Yulis Setyawan (UB, Indonesia), Dr. Lim Thien Sang (UMS, Malaysia), Prof. Dr. Ir. Titi Candra Sunarti (IPB, Indonesia), Dr. Prakash Murgeppa Bhuyar (MJU, Thailand), Dr. Cesar Ontinero (CLSU, Philippines), Graduate School Dean (VSU, Philippines), Dr. Jomar F. Rabajanti (UPLB, Philippines), Dr. Simone

Pfeiffer (UGOE, Germany), and Dr. Lorenz Probst (BOKU, Austria). The Steering Committee is made of representatives/coordinators from each project partner and is higher up in the ladder in terms of decision-making structure. Quarterly committee meetings are expected to be held online to discuss the status of the project implementation, challenges encountered and recommendations.

The Quality Assurance Committee is chaired by Dr. Buncha Chinnasri (Project Coordinator, Kasetsart University, Thailand). The members include Dr. Benjamina Paula Flor (University of the Philippines Los Baños, Philippines), Dr. Cesar Ortinero (Central Luzon State University, Philippines), Prof. Dr. Ir. Imam Santoso (Universitas Brawijaya, Indonesia), Dr. Anabella Tulin (Visayas State University, Philippines), and Dr. Lorenz Probst (The University of Natural Resources and Life Sciences, Austria). This Committee is tasked with encouraging project partners to work professionally and actively. The Committee also develop or revise standards of practice and guidelines to ensure high quality of activities and deliveries. Before all deliverables are submitted to SYGMA, it is the responsibility of the Quality Assurance Committee to perform final check and assessment of the deliverables.

The Conflict Resolution Committee, on the other hand, is chaired by Dr. Glenn B. Gregorio (Southeast Asian Regional Center for Graduate Study and Research in Agriculture, Philippines). The members include Prof. Dr. Ir. Iskandar Zulkarnaen Siregar (The Institut Pertanian Bogor, Indonesia), Prof. Dr. Zalilah Mohd Shariff (Universiti Putra Malaysia, Malaysia), Prof. Budi Guntoro (Universitas Gadjah Mada, Indonesia), Asst. Prof. Anna F. Formalino (University of the Philippines Los Baños, Philippines), Prof. Dr. Lim Thien Sang (Universiti Malaysia Sabah, Malaysia), and Dr. Simone Pfeiffer (University of Gottingen, Germany). The Conflict Resolution Committee is to serve as a mediating body for the purpose of resolving conflicts related to financial, administrative, and implementation issues among project partners and co-ordinator. The Committee also has responsibility for proposing recommendations and resolutions aimed towards the satisfaction of all parties involved.

There were 67 participants attended the Kick-off Meeting. The Kick-off meeting report was submitted to the SYGMA platform on 31 May 2024.

- 2) In March, 2024, EU released 70% of the project fund to Kasetsart University's Main Bank Account.
- 3) Between 22 and 26 April 2024, Kasetsart University hosted the training workshop which was part of Work Package 2 and aimed at providing lessons

to participants on module writing and development based on the list of obtained learning outcomes of micro-credential courses. The general workshop agenda included (1) Orientation on micro-credentials, (2) Module writing and development, (3) Online Learning Materials (e.g., video lecture, e-handout, podcast, and (4) Packaging of modules in an online platform. At the workshop, representatives from each project member had chances to discuss and give their inputs on the content of each learning module. There were 24 participants from project partners attending the April 2024 workshop.

- 4) In May, 2024, Kasetsart University transferred 70% of the project fund to PMC FSCC Project's Bank Account.
- 5) On 30 May 2024, Kasetsart University submitted "Quality Assurance Strategies" for the PMC FSCC project to EU, the project funding agency. Quality Assurance Strategies are created by Kasetsart University with the prime objective of establishing criteria, tools and procedures for monitoring and evaluating the project in terms of processes, practices in line with the project aims and objectives, methodologies and strategies adopted, the timeframe of deliverables, and the budget. The Quality Assurance Strategies focus on identifying processes that will be applied to assure quality, define roles and responsibilities to ensure a successful project and deliverables, provide PMC FSCC management with indicators to allow them to take appropriate decisions, and to track and report on project progress. The Quality Assurance Strategies address three levels: 1) design 2) development, and 3) implementation. They need the coordinated efforts of many individuals, such as those who generate information and those who use the information or make decisions based on those. These individuals include: project members, project coordinators, work package leaders, stakeholders, project staff, etc. In addition, peer reviewers and individuals with varied expertise will be tapped so that critical issues for the success of the project are sufficiently addressed, thus, helping to minimize problems during planning, implementation, and evaluation. The Quality Assurance Strategies also define the roles of project coordinator (PC) and project partners or beneficiaries, the decision-making structure, work package (WP) management, risk management plan, risk handling and monitoring.
- 6) In June 2024, the PMC FSCC project was moved from the Kasetsart University International College (KUIC) to the Faculty of Agriculture, Kasetsart University. From June 2024 to the present time, the PMC FSCC project has been under the supervision of the Faculty of Agriculture: all administrative work and implementation of the PMC FSCC project is led by the Dean of the Faculty of Agriculture. The signatories of the project's bank account were also changed to staff of the Faculty of Agriculture.

7) In September 2024, the PMC FSCC project started releasing 30% personnel cost and expenses for organizing activities or workshops to all partners and hosts. The partnership agreement is also sent out for signatures of all project partners.
