University also certified the Double First-Class Discipline University from the Chinese government with a total of 30,000 students at the present.







asetsart University welcomed the president and vice president of the World Tipitaka Foundation. On 26 November 2021, Dr. Chongrak Wachrinrat, President of Kasetsart University along with university administrators joined in welcoming Thanpuying Varaporn Pramoj Na Ayudhaya, President of the World Tipitaka Foundation and Major Surathat Bunnag, Vice President of the World Tipitaka Foundation on the occasion of an official visit to Kasetsart University to discuss the implementation of the project to improve Chulachomklao of Siam Pāļi Tipiṭaka: A Digital Preservation Edition 2020.


The World Tipiṭaka Project is part of the 100th anniversary of the birth of Her Royal Highness Princess Galyani Vadhana Krom Luang Naradhiwas Rajanagarindra in 2023. The Royal Thai Government and the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) will honor her as one of the most important people in the world. HRH Princess Galyani Vadhana, as Honorary President and Royal Patron, was an honorary chairman of the Roman script project since 2003. The World Tipiṭaka Edition in Roman script is a 40-volume set which was presented as a royal gift from Thailand to 150 important international libraries worldwide.

It is a collaboration between Kasetsart University and the World Tipitaka Foundation to promote the dissemination of Buddhism to the public around the world. The digital version is disseminated in recognition of Her Royal Highness Princess Galyani Vadhana

Krom Luang Naradhiwas Rajanagarindra, as Honorary President and Royal Patron, of translating and publishing the world's first printed set of the Pāli Tipiţaka.

The Buddhist Era 2500 Great International Council Pāļi Tipiţaka, Roman Script 2005 or in short "The World Tipiţaka Edition" is the World Sajjhāya Phonetic Edition (Pāļi Phonetic Alphabet) and (Pāļi Notation) as royal gifts to important institutions in the country and abroad, following in the footsteps of His Majesty King Chulalongkorn who graciously published Chulachomklao of Siam Pāļi Tipiţaka 1893. In this regard, the implementation of the project to improve Chulachomklao of Siam Pāli Tipiţaka: A Digital Preservation Edition 2020 will integrate the body of knowledge, linguistic, cultural analysis, and link to Buddhism from the perspectives of different fields from the experts of each department and lead to the spread of the Tipitaka around the world.

After the discussion, Thanpuying Varaporn Pramoj Na Ayudhaya, President of the World Tipitaka Foundation and Major Surathat Bunnag, Vice President of the World Tipitaka Foundation attended a mini concert from the KU Wind Symphony, Faculty of Humanities and has performed a phonetic recitation and reading of the Tipikata Sajjhāya for administrators and students of Kasetsart University.









KU International Network Seminar 2021:

'Foresight'

n 18 November 2021, the International Affairs Division, Office of the University organized the Online International Relations Network Seminar of Kasetsart University for the year 2021. The topic was 'Foresight', looking beyond international relations. The online seminar initially started off with the first panel session on the Future of Internationalization and University Education. This online seminar was attended by representatives from higher education institutions, international relations network, international development policy committee, and the Committee of International Affairs, Kasetsart University. Students and more than 180 people of the general public also attended this online seminar.

The program started with an opening ceremony of the seminar by Dr. Chongrak Watcharinrat, President of Kasetsart University and was followed by a panel discussion on the topic "The Future of Internationalization in Universities". The discussion included representatives of leading universities in Thailand, including Associate Professor Dr. Natcha Thawesaengskulthai, Vice President for Strategic Planning, Innovation and Global Engagement, Chulalongkorn University; Associate Professor Dr. Surat Teerakapibal, Vice Rector for Administration (Tha Prachan) and International Affairs, Thammasat University; Associate Professor Dr. Nopraenue Sajjarax Dhirathiti, Acting Vice Preseident for International Relations and Corporate Communications, Mahidol University; Assistant Professor Dr. Chaiyan Jettanasen, Vice President for International Affairs, King Mongkut's Institute of Technology Ladkrabang; and Assistant Professor Dr. Kampanat Pensupar, Vice President for International Affairs, Kasetsart University.
