Kasetsart University Announcement
Regarding Safety Measures to Prevent the Spread of COVID-19
Issue 31

This announcement supplements previous Kasetsart University Announcement regarding Safety Measures to Prevent the Spread of COVID-19, Issue 30, issued on 10 July 2021, and the 2005 Executive Decree on Public Administration in Emergency Situation of the Thai Government issued on 1 August 2021.

The Delta variant of the Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) pandemic has proved to be very serious. It is easily transmissible and recently has been spreading quickly and has already infected many people.

Therefore, Kasetsart University shall extend the Safety Measures to Prevent the Spread of Covid-19; as announced previously, all staff shall be permitted to work from home and should be allowed to work on-site at Kasetsart University only when necessary. Also, the faculty are requested to conduct all classes online. Kasetsart University Announcement Regarding Safety Measures to Prevent the Spread of COVID-19, Issue 30, dated 10 July 2021, will be extended for the safety of Kasetsart University's staff and students, and is intended to comply strictly with the extension of the Government's Measure within the area of maximum, strict control.

This announcement will be effective from 26 July 2021 and remain in effect until further notice.
