Kasetsart University Announcement
Regarding Classroom and On-Site Workplace Operations at Kasetsart University
under the Thai Government COVID-19 Relief Measure Issue 26

This announcement is regarding the use of buildings and facilities at Kasetsart University for classroom operations, workplace operations, and any other appropriate activities, in compliance with the Bangkok Metropolitan Administration Announcement (dated 23 February 2021), about relief measures regarding the use of buildings and facilities in schools and educational institutions, by virtue of the authority granted by Section 37 of Kasetsart University Act B.E. 2558. Kasetsart University Announcement Regarding Classroom Operations and On-site Workplace Measures Under the Thai Government COVID-19 Relief Measure Issue 25 no longer applies and is replaced by Kasetsart University Announcement Regarding Classroom and On-site Workplace Operations at Kasetsart University under the Thai Government COVID-19 Relief Measure Issue 26.

1. The department that supervises a venue should manage access and ensure that any activities are organized to comply strictly with health safety measures and guidelines intended to prevent the spread of COVID-19.

1.1 Venues or buildings of Kasetsart University may be used for classroom operations, examinations, training, or any other appropriate activities, but all activities must strictly comply health safety measures and guidelines, particularly taking into account Physical Distancing guidelines. Furthermore, Kasetsart University encourages all faculties/departments to organize classroom operations and examination using online platforms. If class sessions and examinations are conducted on-site, the number of students shall not exceed 50% of the venue's capacity. If there are students from high-risk regions enrolled in the class, the instructor shall provide appropriate online-classroom operations and examinations.

1.2 Stadiums, sports fields, fitness centers, parks, public activity areas, indoor sports courts, and public indoor and outdoor swimming pools may be operated as usual.

1.3 Boxing stadiums and boxing training grounds are allowed to operate normally.

1.4 Libraries, museums, learning centers, botanic gardens, and theaters may be operated as usual.

1.5 Activities that have large number of participants and have a higher risk of disease spreading, such as meetings, seminars, banquets, and other activities, are required to limit the number of participants (not to exceed 300 people). The activity organizer must strictly ensure that the participants follow safety measures and guidelines intended to prevent the spread of COVID-19.

1.6 Banquet services areas and banquet rooms, including any places where banquets are arranged, are requested to limit the number of participants (not to exceed 300 people). Food and beverage shops may be operated as usual, but with a limited number of customers. Customers are permitted to eat inside the shop but must comply with the safety measures and guidelines.

1.7 Kasetsart University Veterinary Teaching Hospital may open and operate as usual.

2. All faculties, departments, institutes, and offices are to resume normal work on-site, Monday to Friday, 08:30-16:30. Supervisory administrative authorities should ensure that staff strictly follow the safety measures and guidelines that are intended to prevent the spread of the COVID-19. Supervisory administrative authorities may assign staff who come from high-risk regions to work from home.

3. Campus offices and training and research stations outside Bangkok shall comply with the provincial and municipal governments' announcements. Heads of training and research stations shall supervise staff and shall appropriately report the needs and situations to their offices.

4. If any operation cannot be conducted according to this announcement, the President shall have final decision-making authority.

This announcement will be effective 1 April 2021 until further notice.
